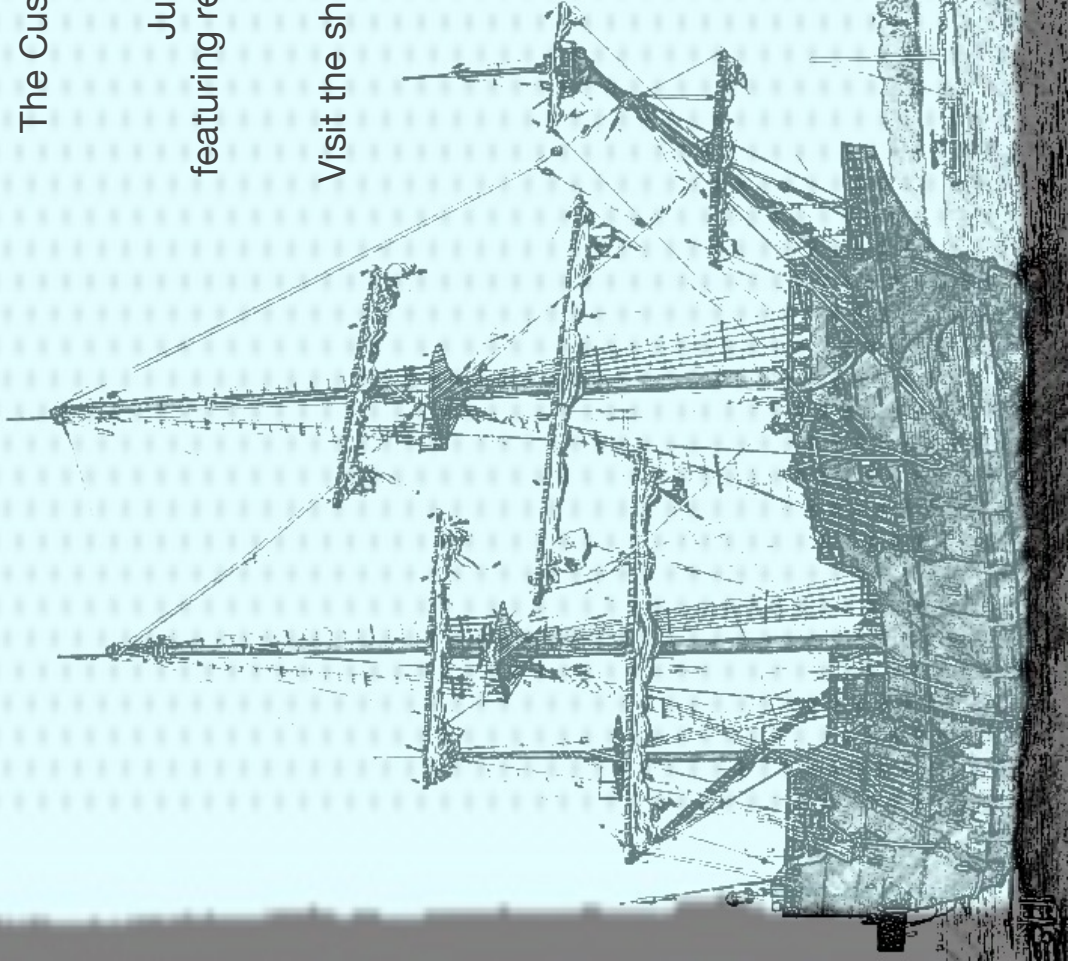
The Customs House Maritime Museum welcomes two tall ships to Newburyport Harbor May 24 - 29, 2017.

Event Rules:

1. Event dates are Saturday, Sunday and Monday - May 27-29, 2017. The event will be open from 9:00am to 5:00 pm on each day of the event.
2. Set-up will take place between 8:00 am and 9:00 am on each day. When unloading, cars can be parked on the right side of the Customs House. As parking near the Customs House is very limited, please be courteous to other exhibitors and move your vehicle after you have unloaded, to make room for others to unload.
3. All merchants will be under a shared 32' x 90' sailcloth event tent. All spaces within this "Collection" tent are 10' x 10', and they will be clearly marked out on the lawn - please stay within your space and keep the aisles and walkways clear at all times.
4. All merchants are responsible for providing their own table and booth furnishings.
5. Merchants are responsible for securing their items each evening. As there will be no overnight security at this outdoor space, it is strongly advised that merchants bring all items of value with them each evening. The Customs House Maritime Museum is not responsible for lost or stolen items during the event.
6. In the event of rain during the event, there will be no refunds of reservation fees.
7. Spaces that are not paid in full within **one week** of the reservation form being received will be made available to other exhibitors.
